eVISA INTRODUCTION

eVISA is an online application platform facility for foreign nationals to apply visa to enter Malaysia for their comfort and convenience.

eVISA can be applied around the world except from Malaysia, Israel and North Korea.

Advisable to use through Singapore Service Provider Network to apply for Malaysia eVISA in Singapore.

1. SOCIAL VISIT PASS

Most foreign visitors can enter Malaysia without having to apply for a visa but if you hold a travel document issued by one of the listed countries on paragraph 2.1 below, you will require a **valid Malaysia eVISA** to enter Malaysia. eVISA does not guarantee entry into Malaysia, but allows you to travel to Malaysia Port of Entry and request a Short Term Social Visit Pass at Malaysian Entry Point.

The Short Term Social Visit Pass given at Malaysia Entry Point to foreign visitors upon arrival is for the following purposes only:

2. MALAYSIA DIGITAL ARRIVAL CARD (MDAC)

Starting from 01 January 2024 it is **MANDATORY** to complete and submit **MALAYSIA DIGITAL ARRIVAL CARD (MDAC)** within 3 days before arrival in Malaysia, except for the specified categories.

CATEGORIES EXEMPTED from filling the MDAC are:

- i. All citizens of Singapore;
- ii. Holders of Diplomatic and Official Passports;
- iii. Malaysian Permanent Residents and Malaysian Long Term Pass Holders;
- iv. Brunei Common Certificate of Identification (GCI);
- v. Holders of Brunei Malaysia Frequent Traveler Facility;
- vi. Thailand Border Pass Holder; and
- vii. Indonesian Cross Border Pass (PLB) holders;

3. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To enter Malaysia, travellers must meet the following immigration requirements:

1. PASSPORT VALIDITY

Have above 6-month passport validity upon entry to Malaysia.

2. VISA

Obtain a visa if you hold a passport of a country that requires a visa to enter Malaysia

3. MALAYSIA DIGITAL ARRIVAL CARD (MDAC)

Three (3) days before arrival in Malaysia, complete and submit **MALAYSIA DIGITAL ARRIVAL CARD (MDAC)**

4. TICKET

A valid and authentic confirmed **FLIGHT / TRAIN / BUS TICKET** return / onward (to another country) **except** for Singapore Permanent Residents, Singapore Employment Pass / S-Pass / Work Permit / Dependant Pass / Student Pass / Long Term Visit Pass Or Other Type Of Pass

5. ACCOMMODATION

Proof of accommodation of **paid HOTEL booking OR LODGING address**, provide a copy of friend / relative's Malaysian Identity Card (MyKad) or foreign identity card (permit / pass issued by Malaysia Immigration Department and provide friend / relative in Malaysia **CONTACT NUMBER**.

6. PROHIBITION/RESTRICTION OF IMPORTS

Ensure that you do not bring [prohibited items](#) into Malaysia, please refer Royal Malaysian Customs Department: http://www.customs.gov.my/en/tp/Pages/tp_ie.aspx

4. CHINA & INDIA EXEMPTED VISA

Visa Liberalisation Plan aims to attract foreign tourists and generate national income. This will ensure Malaysia remains a leader in key industries investment and tourism in the Asian region.

Starting from 01 December 2023 until 31 December 31 2024, citizens of China and India will enjoy visa exemption to Malaysia, with a Short Term Social Visit Pass granting them thirty (30) days per entry provided upon arrival at Malaysia Entry Point.

5.1 WHERE TO APPLY eVISA

Please be informed that there is **NO DIRECT VISA APPLICATION SUBMISSION** at the High Commission Of Malaysia in Singapore excluding **Visa With Reference (VDR)** application and holder of **United Nations Laissez-Passé, Certificate / Document of Identity** travel documents.

Effective from 31 May 2024, services through the appointed agent of the Malaysian Visa Application Handling Agency will **NO LONGER** be available. All applications for eVisa for countries that require a visa are advised to visit the official Malaysian eVisa website <https://malaysiavisa.imi.gov.my> for eVisa applications to Malaysia.

DON'T BE SCAMMED

1. No third party was appointed by Immigration Department as agent for eVisa application.
2. Applicant are advised to be vigilant on fake / illegal websites offering eVisa application services.
3. Please note that there is only one official Malaysian eVisa application website and that is: <https://malaysiavisa.imi.gov.my>

Every visa application including the period of validity is considered **ON ITS OWN MERITS AND IS SUBJECT TO APPROVAL**. High Commission of Malaysia in Singapore do not disclose the reason for rejection due to confidentiality of information. We seek your understanding on this matter.

(No unrelated visitor is allowed to accompany applicant EXCEPT for elderly, disable or underage)

VEHICLE ENTRY PERMIT (VEP) AND ROAD CHARGE (RC)

Vehicle Entry Permit (VEP) is a permit issued by the Road Transport Department (under Section 66H of the Road Transport Act 1987) that allows the entry of foreign vehicles into Malaysia. Owners or representatives duly appointed by the owners of ALL foreign registered vehicles entering Peninsular Malaysia are required to register online for VEP through this portal. VEP registered vehicles will be issued non-transferrable RFD tags that uniquely identify each vehicle.

Road charge (RC) is a fee imposed on all foreign registered private vehicles (excluding motorcycles) when entering Malaysia. The fee of RM20.00 will be charged each time these vehicles enter the country.

2. TOUCH 'N GO

Touch 'n Go eWallet is a Malaysian digital wallet and online payment platform to make payments for tolls, street parking, payment on e-hailing and many more.

Singapore-registered vehicles are required to pay a Road Charge (RC) of RM20 (S\$6.40) for entry at Malaysia's land checkpoints - either at the Woodlands Causeway or Tuas Second Link.

Travellers must ensure that the Touch 'n Go cards are valid with enough money to make payment for Road Charge (RC) and Toll Fares (refer below), in order to prevent congestion and delays at the checkpoints.
