REQUIREMENTS TO FILL IN THE PRE-DEPARTURE FORM VIA THE MYSEJAHTERA APPLICATION FOR TRAVELLERS ENTERING MALAYSIA FROM ABROAD

With reference to the matter above the Ministry of Health (MOH) would like to inform that:

2. The main process of screening travellers from abroad include the process of **downloading and activating MySejahtera** application by Travellers **prior to departure**, followed by **scanning the QR code** for the 'Travellers from Abroad' and completing the MySejahtera Pre Departure Travel form via the MySejahtera application at the country's Point of Entry (POE).
3. Constant efforts were taken to ensure MySejahtera application is more user-friendly. It has new useful feature to ease the screening process and facilitate the entry of travellers at the POE. A new **'Travellers' icon** on the MySejahtera application's homepage has been created where it provides links related to travellers **before** they pursue their journey to Malaysia.

4. **MySejahtera Traveller** provides:
 - 4.1 a link to **apply for a digital vaccination certificate** via the MySejahtera application for travellers who have been vaccinated abroad.
 - 4.2 a **pre-departure form** which requires details on personal information, health declaration, vaccination status, and quarantine information **before they depart to Malaysia**. This will facilitate their entrance process at POE. Therefore, travellers will no longer be required to scan the MySejahtera QR code and fill in this information in the MySejahtera app upon arrival at the POE. However if they did not fill in the pre-departure form, their entrance process at POE will be longer and more tedious.
 - 4.3 a link directed to the Home Quarantine Application (HQA) portal (<https://hso.moh.gov.my/outbreak-portal-hqa/index>) is also available to facilitate travellers who are eligible to apply for home quarantine.
5. In conjunction with that, every traveller from abroad will be required to fulfil the following criteria **before they depart** to Malaysia: -
 - 5.1 Travellers who have received COVID-19 vaccination abroad will have to **apply for a digital vaccination certificate** in the MySejahtera application by using the link provided in MySejahtera 'Traveller' icon as early as **five (5) days before** departing to Malaysia.
 - 5.2 Travellers will be required to **fill in the pre-departure form** provided in MySejahtera Traveller icon. Information needed such as personal details, vaccinations, date of arrival, and place of quarantine are to be filled in accurately to ensure that further screening upon arrival runs smoothly. Appendix 1 can be referred for guidance to fill in the pre-departure form.

5. We highly appreciate the assistance and cooperation from YBhg. Tan Sri/ Datuk Wira/ Datuk/ Dato' Sri/ Sir in informing these procedures to the travellers from abroad. These instructions to travellers are also requested to be uploaded on the official websites and social media platforms of respective departments. The airline will also need to check that every traveller from abroad execute these instructions **before boarding the flight**.
6. The MOH is grateful for your support to ease the process of opening the borders. We hope that the implementation of this new procedure will ease the traveling process for the travellers and reduce congestion at POE, especially in the event of the opening of the borders soon.
